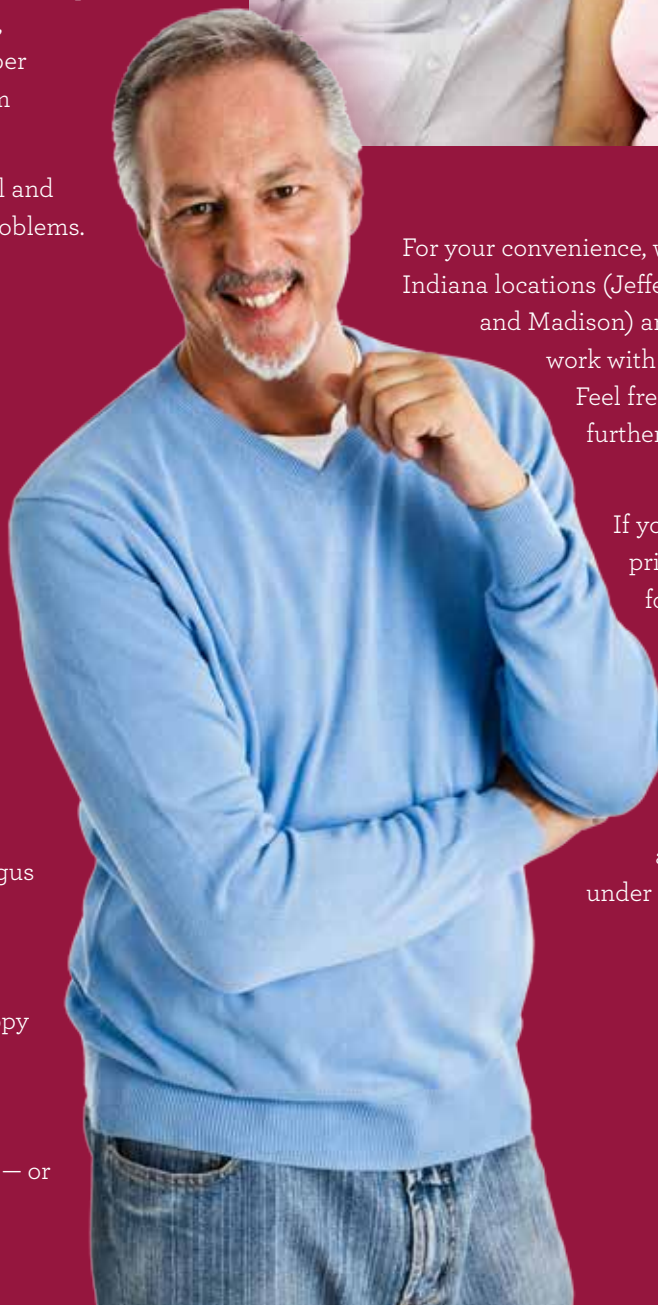

Vascular care includes both surgical and non-surgical care of blood vessel problems. Our expertise includes:

- Peripheral artery disease (PAD)
- Non-healing leg sores
- Carotid artery disease
- Abdominal aneurysms
- Hemodialysis access
- Symptomatic varicose veins
- RFA vein ablation
- Venous Insufficiency

Thoracic care includes surgical and non-surgical treatment of non-cardiac chest disease. Our expertise includes:

- Lung nodules and lung masses
- Pleural effusions
- Cancers of the lung and esophagus
- Hyperhidrosis
- Pacemaker implant
- Anterior spine exposure
- Bronchoscopy and esophagoscopy
- VATs (video assisted Thoracoscopy)
- Nissen Fundoplication (to treat gastroesophageal reflux disease — or GERD — and Hiatal Hernias)
